

Introduction

History of the Core-Edge Working Group

- Established around February 2004
- First appearance at MIT eBiz in May 2004
- Started work around same time:
 - Conducted five case studies
 - VOIP, SIP, LBS, Music, RFID
 - Developed core-edge taxonomy
 - Developed core-edge methodology
 - Concepts of control points, gear teeth, coreness, ...
- Roughly bi-weekly WG meetings
 - Involvement of key sponsors
 - Dial-in provided
- Workshops : September 2004
 May 2005
